## Format:

Divisions may play either a round-robin and/or double-elimination tournament. All teams are guaranteed three games.

## Awards:

Each game will have two certified or qualified officials with one score keeper for each game. The home team will be determined by the team listed on the bottom of the bracket or listed first in round-robin play. Home team must provide a scorekeeper.

## KSHSAA rules apply, with the following modifications:

1. Six-minute quarters (1st-2nd grades) and eight-minute quarters (3rd-12th grades). Clock stops on time-outs, injuries, shooting fouls, and the last two minutes of the fourth quarter on all dead-ball situations. (If one team is ahead by 20 points then the clock will not stop in the last two minutes.)
2. All teams must have numbered jerseys.
3. All teams (except for grades 1st and 2nd) can use a full court press. Teams in 3rd-6th grades can use it unless they are ahead by 15 points. There are no limitations in grades 7th-12th on full court pressing.
4. The 1st and 2nd grade boys will use the junior sized ball. Third-6th grade boys will use the intermediate size ball. Grades 7th-12th will use regulation size ball.
5. The 1st-4th grade girls will use the junior sized ball. Fifth-12th grade girls will use the intermediate sized ball.
6. Grades 1st and 2nd will play cross-court on eight foot goals.
7. Two time outs per half, and one time out for overtimes are allowed.
8. Overtime will be three minutes.
9. Younger players may play up in older divisions, but older players may not play in younger age divisions.
10. Player information must be correct and current. If incorrect information is submitted, that player/team may be ineligible.
11. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. The Tournament Director or any game official may remove a player, coach, or fan from a game or tournament for inappropriate behavior. Each coach is responsible for the conduct of the team's players, coaches, and fans on and off the court.
12. If anything else arises ask the Tournament Director or gym supervisors.
